**PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE**

TO: Melbourne beachside water customers from Wallace Avenue north to Pineda Causeway

---

Work is underway to repair a large water main break on Burns Boulevard in Indian Harbour Beach. Therefore, as a precaution, we advise that all water used for drinking, cooking, making ice, brushing teeth, or washing dishes, be boiled. A rolling boil of one minute is sufficient. As an alternative, bottled water may be used.

This precautionary boil water notice is expected to remain in effect until the required bacteriological survey shows that the water is safe to drink. You will be provided with a notification at that time.
