PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE

TO: Melbourne water customers in Satellite Beach at the following addresses:

Water has been shut off to your property to repair a broken water valve in the area. Therefore, as a precaution once water service is restored, we advise that all water used for drinking, cooking, making ice, brushing teeth, or washing dishes, be boiled. A rolling boil of one minute is sufficient. As an alternative, bottled water may be used.

This precautionary boil water notice is expected to remain in effect until the required bacteriological survey shows that the water is safe to drink. You will be provided with a notification at that time.
